PGC BRINGS MEDICAL AND DENTAL MISSION TO BRGY. SAN FRANCISCO, GENERAL TRIAS

On January 13, a total of 354 residents received medical consultations while 75 patients availed of dental services during a Medical and Dental Mission spearheaded by the Provincial Government of Cavite in Barangay San Francisco, City of General Trias.

PAGKUMPISKA NG DRIVER'S LICENSE: MAY HANGGANAN ANG KAPANGYARIHAN NG LGU TRAFFIC ENFORCER

Ang pagpapatupad ng batas-trapiko ay may layuning panatilihin ang kaayusan at kaligtasan sa kalsada. Ngunit ang kapangyarihang ito ay may malinaw na hangganan sa ilalim ng batas.

Sa ilalim ng RA 4136 (Land Transportation and Traffic Code), ang Driver's License ay inisyu at nire-regulate ng Land Transportation Office (LTO). Dahil dito, ang mga patakaran kung kailan ito maaaring kunin o hindi ay itinatakda sa national level, at ipinatutupad sa pamamagitan ng opisyal na issuances ng LTO at DOTr.

Kapag ipinagbabawal ng national policy ang pagkumpiska

Kung may umiiral na patakaran na hindi pinapahintulutan ang pagkumpiska ng Driver's License at ipinilit pa rin itong kunin, ang aksyon ay maaaring ituring na lampas sa itinakdang kapangyarihan.

Ito ay hindi usapin ng pagsuway sa tao, kundi pagsuway sa batas at sa national policy na nagpapatupad nito.

Mga posibleng legal na implikasyon
Kapag napatunayang walang legal na basehan ang pagkumpiska, maaaring pumasok ang usapin sa ilalim ng umiiral na batas at patakaran, tulad ng:

- Usurpation of Authority (RPC Art. 177), kung ang kapangyarihang ginamit ay hindi ipinagkaloob ng batas

- Grave Abuse of Authority o violation of civil service rules, bilang usapin ng administrative accountability

- Civil liability, kung may napatunayang pinsala o perhuwisyo sa motorista

Ang mga ito ay hindi awtomatikong parusa, kundi mga posibleng legal na epekto na dumadaan pa rin sa due process.

Paalala para sa lahat ng traffic enforcers
Ang pinaka-ligtas at tamang hakbang kung may paglabag sa trapiko ay:

- mag-isyu ng citation o ticket, at sundin ang umiiral na national policy tungkol sa Driver's License.

- Ito ay proteksyon sa motorista at proteksyon din sa enforcer laban sa hindi kinakailangang legal na isyu.

BOTTOM LINE

Ang kapangyarihan sa kalsada ay hiram ng batas, at ang batas ang nagtatakda ng hangganan nito.

Kapag malinaw ang patakaran ng LTO at DOTr, ito ang dapat sundin upang maging patas, propesyonal, at legal ang pagpapatupad ng batas-trapiko.

Makikinabang din ang mga Pilipinong nagtatrabaho sa healthcare, IT, konstruksyon, turismo, at iba pang sektor sa mas bukas na access sa UAE.

Kasabay nito, nilagdaan din ang kasunduan sa defense cooperation na magpapalakas sa ugnayang pangkalakalan at pangseguridad ng dalawang bansa.

The Digital Financial Inclusion Awards (DFIA) is a financial inclusion initiative funded by the Citi Foundation, in partnership with Microfinance Council and supported by Citi Philippines and the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP).

Now in its fourth year when it spun off from the previously known Citi Microentrepreneurship Awards (CMA), it recognizes outstanding micro-

BSP Governor Eli M. Remolona Jr.

Umakyat na sa pitong sibilyan ang inaresto ng Philippine National Police—Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (PNP—CIDG) kaugnay ng kaso ng mga nawawalang sabungero.

Bago ito, siyam na pulis na ang nadakip at kasalukuyang nasa kustodiya ng CIDG bilang bahagi ng patuloy na imbestigasyon.

Sa isang press briefing sa Camp Crame, inihayag ni CIDG Director PMGEN Robert Alexander Morico III na ang mga nadakip na sibilyan ay pawang mga security personnel at empleyado ng sabungan na iniuugnay kay negosyanteng si Charlie "Atong" Ang.

Ayon pa sa CIDG, umabot na sa 17 ang naaresto mula sa kabuuang 18 akusado na pinaghanap batay sa mga warrant of arrest na inilabas ng Laguna Regional Trial Court Branch 26.

Patuloy namang tinutugis ng mga awtoridad si Ang at isang dating pulis na nananatiling at large.

CAMP CAPIN-PIN, Rizal — Patuloy na tinitiyak ng mahigpit na ugnayan sa pagitan ng Pamahalaang Bayan ng Abra de Ilog at ng 2nd Infantry (Jungle Fighter) Division ng Philippine Army ang maayos na kalagayan at kapakanan ng nasagip na Filipino-American na si Chantal Anicoche, kasunod ng engkuwentro noong Enero 1 sa Occidental Mindoro.

Bilang bahagi ng follow-up medical intervention, personal na nagsagawa ng pagsusuri noong Enero 8 si Municipal Health Officer Dr. Mianne Airish Hernandez kay Anicoche sa lugar kung saan siya pansamantalang nasa kustodiya ng mga tropa ng 76th Infantry (Victrix) Battalion.

Isinagawa ang naturang pagsusuri alinsunod sa direktiba ni Abra de Ilog Mayor Meg Constantino upang matiyak ang kanyang pisikal na kalagayan matapos ang ilang araw na pananatili sa kabundukan.

Ayon kay Dr. Hernandez, bagama't may natukoy na ilang kagat ng insekto sa mga braso at binti ni Anicoche, wala naman umanong nakitang malubhang sugat o palatandaan ng pisikal na pang-aabuso. Agad siyang binigyan ng kinakailangang gamot at inirekomendang sumailalim pa sa patuloy na obserbasyon at karagdagang pangangalaga.

Samantala, sinabi ni 2nd Infantry (Jungle Fighter) Division Spokesperson at Division Public Affairs Office Chief Colonel Michael Aquino na ang

isinagawang independent medical assessment ng LGU ay mahalagang patunay ng transparency at propesyonalismo sa pagtugon sa mga usaping makatao.

"Ang malayang pagpasok ng municipal health officer at ang malinaw na medical findings ay nagpapatunay na ang kalagayan ni Chantal ay ligtas at maayos. Ito rin ay nagsisilbing sagot sa mga maling impormasyong kumakalat online," pahayag ni Aquino.

Dagdag pa niya, ang aktibong partisipasyon ng lokal na pamahalaan ay nakatulong upang pabulaanan ang mga alegasyong may mga sibilyang sinaktan o inabuso sa mga operasyon noong Enero 1, na umano'y walang batayan batay sa aktuwal na resulta ng pagsusuri.

Muling pinasalamatan ng 2nd Infantry Division ang Pamahalaang Bayan ng Abra de Ilog sa maagap na pagtugon at patuloy na koordinasyon, at binigyang-diin na ang ganitong pagtutulungan ay mahalaga sa pagtitiyak ng dignidad, kaligtasan, at karapatan ng bawat indibidwal na apektado ng armadong tunggalian.

BARAS, Rizal — Isang 44-anyos na lalaki ang sugatan at kasalukuyang nagpagagamot matapos umanong aksidenteng pumutok ang isang improvised shotgun habang sila ay sakay ng motorsiklo sa Southville 9, Barangay Pinugay, Baras, Rizal.

Kinilala ang biktima na si Cirilo, isang vulcanizer at residente ng nasabing barangay. Ayon sa ulat ng Baras Municipal Police Station (MPS), naganap ang insidente bandang alas-11:00 ng umaga noong Enero 14, 2026, ngunit iniulat lamang sa pulisya dakong alas-9:50 ng umaga noong Enero 15, 2026.

Batay sa imbestigasyon, nakatanggap ng tawag ang Baras MPS mula sa isang concerned citizen hinggil sa nasabing insidente. Agad na rumsponde ang mga pulis at beripikahin ang ulat, subalit pagdating sa lugar ay napag-alamang naidala na ang biktima sa Amang Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center upang gamutin ang tinampong pinsala.

Sa isinagawang pagsisiyasat sa lugar ng insidente, narekober ng mga pulis ang isang (1) improvised shotgun o sumpak. Natagpuan din ang isang itim na Yamaha Mio i125 na minamaneho

ng isinasagawang imbestigasyon ng Baras MPS upang matukoy ang kabuuang detalye ng insidente.

Isusumite ang narekober na improvised shotgun at mga bala sa Provincial Forensic Unit (PFU) para sa ballistic examination, habang isasailalim naman sa beripikasyon ang motorsiklong nasangkot sa insidente.

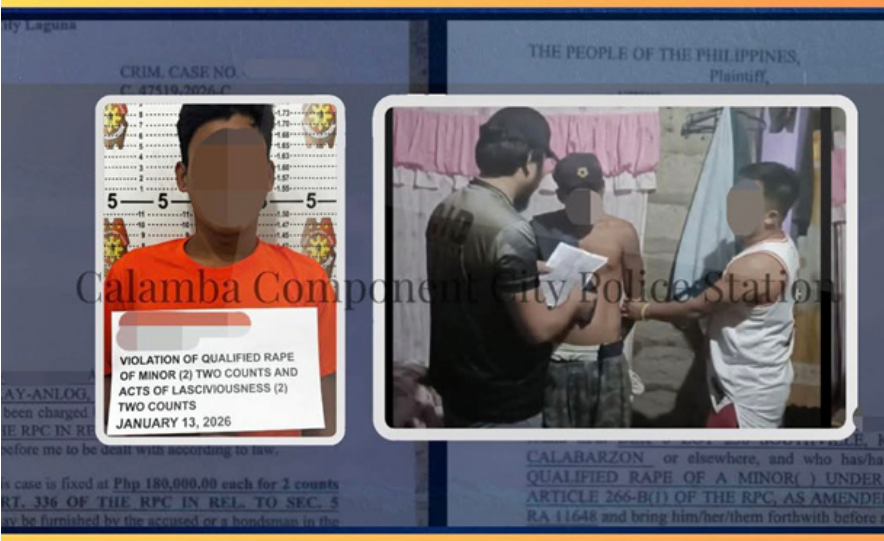

Hustisya para kay Gianni: Walang Oras ang Dapat Masayang

Sa bawat balitang may kinalaman sa pagkamatay ng isang bata, hindi lamang galit ang gumuhit sa damdamin ng publiko—kundi matinding tanong: May hustisya pa ba para sa mga walang kalaban-laban?

Sa San Pablo City, ang tanong na ito ay malinaw na tinutugunan ng pamahalaang panlalawigan ng Laguna.

Mariing inatasan ni Governor Sol Aragonese ang agarang pag-usad ng kaso ng batang si Gianni, na nasawi sa isang karumal-dumal na insidente. Walang paligoy-ligoy ang direktiba ng gobernador sa Laguna Provincial Police: gawing prayoridad ang imbestigasyon at panagutin ang mga may sala—agad.

Sleeping Man Beaten to Death in Calamba; Police File Murder Case Against Jealous Ex-Partner

CALAMBA CITY, Laguna — A 21-year-old man died after being brutally assaulted by the former live-in partner of his girlfriend in Barangay Site, Calamba City, in the early hours of Friday, January 9, 2026, police said. The victim, identified as James, was asleep inside a room with his girlfriend, Leana, when the suspect allegedly entered and launched a sudden and violent attack. CCTV footage showed the suspect barging into the room and repeatedly punching James while he was defenseless. Authorities said the victim sustained at least 20 consecutive punches and two powerful kicks to the head. Despite Leana's attempts to stop the assault, the suspect continued the attack. "Itong lalaking sumugod ay kanyang karelasyon dalawang taon

na ang nakakalipas na dating nakatira doon. At itong bahay na ito ay pagmamay-ari ng magulang ng witness, itong babae na kinakasama ng victim," said Police Captain Benhur Balgemino, Assistant Chief of the Investigation Section of the Calamba PNP. Leana told police that the suspect had earlier asked permission to enter the house, claiming he would only get clothes for their four-year-old child. However, authorities said his true intention appeared to be violent. Following the attack, James was rushed to the hospital, where he remained confined for four days due to severe head injuries. He even celebrated his birthday at the hospital on January 11. However, his condition worsened, and he died on the afternoon of January 14 due to compli-

cations from serious head trauma. Police said jealousy may have been the motive behind the crime, based on statements from Leana and the victim's mother. The 23-year-old suspect is now facing a murder charge and has reportedly gone into hiding after failing to appear at a barangay summons starting January 10. "murder ang isasampang kaso kasi po itong ating biktima ay natutulog, walang kalaban-laban, pinagsusuntok ng suspect," said PLtCol. Dennis C. De Guzman. PLtCol. De Guzman added that authorities are just awaiting the victim's death certificate and additional documents from the family and partner to formally file the case as police continue their manhunt for the suspect. "17 Arrested as Police Tighten Net on Missing Cockfighting Case; Businessman Atong Ang Named PH's Most Wanted"



PHILIPPINES — The Philippine National Police-Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (PNP-CIDG) has arrested seven civilians in connection with the high-profile case of the missing cockfighting enthusiasts, bringing the total number of suspects in custody to 17. CIDG Director PMGEN Robert Alexander Morico III announced during a press briefing at Camp Crame that the seven civilians recently apprehended are security personnel and cockpit employees allegedly linked to businessman Charlie "Atong" Ang. Prior to this, nine police officers had already been arrested and are now under CIDG custody as part of the ongoing

investigation. According to the CIDG, the arrests stem from warrants issued by the Regional Trial Court of Laguna, Branch 26, which named 18 accused in relation to the disappearance of the sabungeros. Authorities confirmed that only one suspect remains unaccounted for. The CIDG said manhunts are continuing for Ang and a former police officer who are both still at large. Meanwhile, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has officially designated Charlie "Atong" Ang as the country's Number One Most Wanted. DILG Secretary Jonvic Remulla said Ang is accused in

the disappearance and alleged killing of more than a hundred cockfighting participants. Remulla also announced a ₱10-million reward for information that would lead to Ang's arrest, with the funds to be sourced from the DILG's budget. He warned that Ang is considered armed and dangerous, citing reports that the businessman is heavily guarded by multiple bodyguards. Authorities assured the public that the government remains committed to pursuing all those involved and bringing justice to the families of the missing sabungeros, as the investigation continues to widen.
