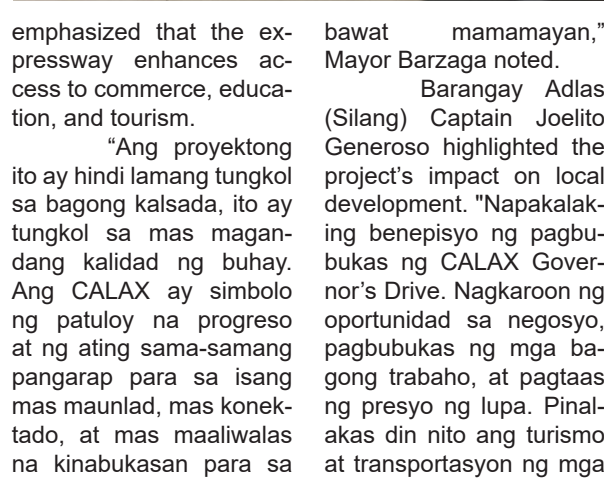


# LGUs, Business Leaders Highlight CALAX Subsection 3's Role in Driving Growth



The economic landscape of Cavite is poised for greater growth following the opening of the Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX) Subsection 3, extending the expressway to Governor's Drive Interchange in General Trias City.

With CALAX now spanning 26 kilometers from Mamplasan, Bifian, Laguna to General Trias, Cavite, local government officials and business leaders cited the project's role in improving connectivity, attracting investments, and creating new opportunities for businesses and communities.

Florencio Ayos, President of the Gen-Tri Business Club, said the new subsection is a long-awaited development that cuts travel time between Laguna and Cavite's industrial hubs to just 26 minutes.

"We are no longer a destination that is hard to reach — we are now a city that is impossible to ignore. Infrastructure is not just about roads; it is about opening doors for every Filipino entrepreneur. General Trias is now better positioned than ever to attract investments, generate employment, and build a more

resilient economy," Ayos stated.

General Trias City Mayor Luis "Jon Jon" Ferrer IV described the new interchange as 'a gateway to greater opportunities' that positions the city as a thriving center of industry. "Habang patuloy na lumalaga ang General Trias bilang sentro ng industriya at kaunlaran, mahalaga ang proyektong tulad nito upang mas mailapit ang mga oportunidad sa ating mga kababayan," said Mayor Ferrer.

The positive outlook was echoed by Dasmariñas City Mayor Jennifer Barzaga, who

Meanwhile, Barangay San Francisco (General Trias) Captain Ryan Santor pointed to the long-term benefits of improved accessibility. "We believe that the opening of CALAX SS3 will bring lasting benefits to nearby communities through improved connectivity, increased investments, and easier transportation of goods and services," said Barangay Capt. Santor.

Beyond improving travel, the opening of CALAX Subsection 3 is expected to strengthen trade, support business expansion, and enhance Cavite's competitiveness as an investment destination.

Calamba is an MPCALA Holdings Inc. project with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) as project grantor.

MPCALA Holdings Inc., the developer and operator of CALAX, is a subsidiary of the Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation (MPTC), the toll road arm of the Metro Pacific Investments Corporation (MPIC). PR

emphasized that the expressway enhances access to commerce, education, and tourism.

## Calamba Marks 128th Philippine Independence Day with Patriotic Ceremony at City Hall



CALAMBA CITY, Laguna — The City Government of Calamba commemorated the 128th Philippine Independence Day with a solemn and patriotic ceremony held at the Calamba City Hall on Friday, June 12, 2026.

Senate President Alan Peter Cayetano on Tuesday raised concerns over reports that the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) had informed only select senators of an alleged threat against the Senate, while also questioning why the warning surfaced at this particular time.

The issue arose after Senator Sherwin Gatchalian disclosed that some senators had been briefed by the NBI about a supposed threat to the institution, prompting heightened security measures within the Senate.

Cayetano said any credible threat against the Senate should have been relayed to all senators and coordinated through the Office of the Sergeant-at-Arms, which is responsible for the institution's security.

"If the threat is credible, then every Senator, every member of the Secretariat, and every individual who works within these walls deserves to be informed and protected," Cayetano said in a state-

ment issued June 9. "Security is not the concern of one bloc. It is the concern of the entire Senate," he added.

He questioned why the information was reportedly disclosed only to certain senators and not to the entire chamber.

"The moment a 'security threat' is briefed to some and withheld from others, it ceases to be a security matter and becomes a political instrument," he said.

Cayetano also raised concerns about the source of the reported intelligence.

"It did not come from the Senate's own Office of the Sergeant-at-Arms, the office constitutionally charged with protecting this institution. It came from the NBI," he said.

He said the reported intelligence should first be verified before being accepted as fact and called for a clearer accounting of how the information was obtained and communicated.

CLARK FREE-PORT ZONE, Pampanga, June 9, 2026 — A commemorative marker honoring the 1991 eruption of Mt. Pinatubo was unveiled at the Clark Parade Grounds, marking the 35th anniversary of one of the most defining natural disasters in Philippine history and highlighting a shared story of resilience, recovery, and regional transformation.

LUCENA CITY, Quezon Province — The Provincial Government of Quezon, through its tourism, culture, and arts stakeholders, conducted the "Huling Parangal sa Watawat ng Pilipinas" (Final Tribute to the Philippine Flag) on Friday, June 5, 2026, at Perez Park in Lucena City, as part of the province's observance of National Flag Days and the commemoration of the country's rich history and patriotism.

To provide them with a deeper understanding of how CARD MRI reaches and serves communities, participants were divided into two groups for the center meeting visits.
