QUEZON CITY — Matagumpay na narekober ng Quezon City Police District (QCPD) ang isang pampasaherong bus na iniulat na hindi na ibinalik ng driver at konduktor nito matapos ang isinagawang follow-up operation sa Rodriguez, Rizal.

Sa ulat ng QCPD sa pamumuno ni PBGen. Randy Glenn Silvio, ang insidente ay nag-ugat sa umano'y paglabag sa tiwala ng driver na kinilalang si alias "David" ng Cainta, Rizal at ng konduktor na si alias "Argel" ng San Jose, Rodriguez, Rizal, na kapwa nahaharap ngayon sa kasong paglabag sa Republic Act No. 10883 o ang New Anti-Carnapping Act of 2016.

Ayon sa imbestigasyon, nagtungo noong Hulyo 9 sa District Anti-Carnapping Unit (DACU) ang operator ng bus upang iulat na hindi naibalik sa kanya ang isang 2011 Daewoo BH115E na may plakang UVL-197, sa kabilang ng paulit-ulit na panawagan sa mga responsable. Nabatid din ng operator na namataan umano ang naturang sasakyan sa Rodriguez, Rizal kaya agad siyang humingi ng tulong sa pulisya para sa agarang pagbawi nito.

Agad namang nagsagawa ng follow-up operation ang mga operatiba ng DACU sa pangunguna ni PLTCOL Hector Ortencio sa Barangay San Jose, Rodriguez, Rizal. Sa kanilang paghahanap, natagpuan ang naturang bus na nakaparada at walang

nagbabantay sa loob ng isang dumpsite.

Batay sa salaysay ng isang testigo, isang hindi nakikilalang lalaki ang nagparada ng bus sa lugar noong Hunyo 2026 at hindi na muling bumalik. Kalaunan ay positibong kinilala ng operator ang sasakyan bilang siya ring iniulat na nawawala.

Nagsampa na ng kasong paglabag sa New Anti-Carnapping Act of 2016 ang mga awtoridad laban sa dalawang suspek sa Quezon City Prosecutor's Office. Samantala, nananatili sa kustodiya ng District Anti-Carnapping Unit ang narekober na bus habang isinasagawa ang beripikasyon sa Land Transportation Office (LTO) at hinihintay ang pagsumite ng kaukulang dokumento ng rehistradong may-ari.

Binigyang-diin ni PBGen. Silvio na ang mabilis na pagtugon at masusing follow-up operation ng mga operatiba ang naging susi sa matagumpay na pagbawi ng sasakyan. Aniya, magpapatuloy ang pinaigting na kampanya ng QCPD laban sa mga krimeng may kaugnayan sa mga sasakyan at tininyak na mananagot ang sinumang lalabag sa batas.

The training featured technical discussions on key components of local investment programming by OPPDC staff. Engr. Gretzel Bea Ganaba discussed the National Mandated Appropriations on Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (LDRRM), providing participants with guidance on complying with statutory requirements for disaster preparedness and resilience. Engr. Alisxander Joshua P. Concluding the two-day workshop, Engr. Leyran encouraged the participants to apply the knowledge and skills they acquired in crafting strategic and responsive Annual Investment Programs that are aligned with national policies and responsive to the development priorities of their respective local government units.

As Cavite continues to experience rapid urbanization, industrial growth, and increasing demand for public services, the Provincial Government remains steadfast in investing in capacity development initiatives that enhance institutional effectiveness and improve public service delivery. — OPIO



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DTI's KALAKAL trade fair generates P8.4M.in MSME sales



The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Region IV-A generated significant market opportunities for local micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) at the recent 13th KALAKAL CALABARZON Regional Trade Fair. The five-day event recorded P8,456,449.60 million in sales, surpassing its original P5 million target and helping local businesses expand their market reach.

The trade fair featured 51 DTI-assisted MSMEs from the provinces of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, and Quezon. The event provided these entrepreneurs with a direct platform to connect with bulk buyers, boost retail sales, and introduce locally made products to a wider market.

DTI Regional Operations Group Supervising Head Undersecretary Blesila Lantayona emphasized the important role these trade fairs play in helping entrepreneurs scale up.

She commended the DTI-CALABARZON team for continuously creating avenues that allow small businesses to showcase their products, strengthen their brand identities, and increase market competitiveness.

"At the DTI, our goal is to help our entrepreneurs transition from micro to small, from small to medium, and from medium to large enterprises, and ultimately becoming globally competitive businesses and exporters," Undersecretary Lantayona said.

Beyond immediate sales, organizers noted that KALAKAL serves as an incubator for long-term business growth, prompting entrepreneurs to improve product quality and gain vital market exposure.

Marilyn Del Rosario of Daine, a wom-

en-led cacao enterprise under the Association of Daine Lady Farmers in Indang, Cavite, shared that DTI's training, packaging assistance, and event placement made their locally produced tablea more recognizable in the market, enabling them to scale up production. Similarly, Valerieza Orio, owner of Nana's Craft in Angono, Rizal, credited the agency's mentoring initiatives with transforming her crochet hobby into a viable business.

As a graduate of the Kapatid Mentor ME (KMME) Program and currently a mentee under the One Town, One Product (OTOP) Program, Orio said DTI's continued business coaching has opened doors for her to showcase her work at both regional and national trade fairs.

DTI Regional Director Marissa C. Argente lauded the exhibitors for their resilience, innovation, and commitment to excellence, calling the trade fair a gateway to larger consumer markets.

"The success of KALAKAL CALABARZON 2026 reflects the strength and competitiveness of our MSMEs," Argente said. "Surpassing our sales target demonstrates a growing appreciation for locally made products and the increasing confidence of consumers and buyers in the quality of regional enterprises."

To recognize outstanding innovation and market performance, the trade fair concluded with the presentation of the Most Innovative Product and Top Seller Awards.

In the food category for innovation, Anitta Café (Batangas) secured first place, followed by R3B2P Ube Manufacturing (Rizal) and Café Cuatro PH Coffee Store (Laguna). In the non-food category, Olvin Scrapwood Furniture and Antique (Quezon) took top honors, with Wangis Laro at Kwentto Corp. (Cavite) and Vin Vie Integrated Farm (Batangas) rounding out the top three.

For the Top Seller Awards, Mira's Food and Agrivulture Inc. (Batangas) won first place in the food category, followed by Phil. Morinda Citrifolia Inc. (Laguna) and Sauce On Food House (Rizal). In the non-food category, Camar Creation Furniture Design Corporation (Quezon) claimed the top spot, followed by Souq Salamanca Artisan Arts and Crafts (Batangas) and Olvin Scrapwood Furniture and Antiques (Quezon).

Sa lipunang matagal nang kulang ang mga programang tunay na nakatuon sa mga batang may Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), isang hakbang na nagbibigay ng pag-asa ang patuloy na pagpapatupad ng "Akay ni Gob sa May Autism" ng Pamahalaang Panlalawigan ng Laguna sa pangunguna ni Governor Sol Aragon.

Noong Hulyo 9, umabot ang pagpaparehistro ng programa sa Ikalawang Distrito ng Laguna sa Hectan Extension Office sa Calamba City sa pangangasiwa ng Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO). Ngunit higit pa sa simpleng registration ang naging kabuluhan ng aktibidad. Ito ay naging pagkakataon upang marinig ang mga tinig ng mga magulang, lolo't lola, at tagapag-alaga na araw-araw na humaharap sa hamon ng pag-aaruga sa kanilang mga anak at apo na may autism.

Isa sa mga kapansin-pansing mensahe ng mga benepisyaryo ay ang matagal nilang paghintay sa isang programang tunay na kumikilala sa kanilang kalagayan. Marami ang nag-aakalang ang tulong ay para lamang sa mga batang kasalukuyang sumasailalim sa therapy. Kaya naman malaking ginawa ang malaman nilang maaari rin silang maging bahagi ng programa kahit hindi na aktibong nagpagamot ang kanilang anak.

Masasalamain sa kanilang mga pahayag ang katotohanang hindi lamang pinansiyal ang kanilang pangangailangan. Ang pagpapalaki ng isang batang may autism ay nangangailangan ng matinding pasensya, sapat na kaalaman, at malaking gastusin. Para sa maraming pamilya, bawat tulong na kanilang natatanggap ay nagbibigay ng kaunting ginawa sa mabigat na responsibilidad na kanilang pasan.

Lalong naging makahulugan ang pahayag ng isang lola na nagsabing kailangang-kailangan ng kanyang apo ang naturang suporta. Ipinakikita nito na hindi lamang mga magulang ang nakikipaglaban para sa kapakanan ng mga batang may autism. Marami ring lola, lola, at iba pang kamag-anak ang nagsisilbing pangunahing tagapag-alaga at umaasa rin sa tulong ng pamahalaan.

Higit sa lahat, naging malinaw ang panawagan ng ilang magulang na sana'y hindi lamang tulong pinansiyal ang maging tugon ng pamahalaan. Hangad nilang magkaroon sa lalawigan ng sariling occupational at behavioral therapy facilities upang hindi na sila mapilitang bumiyahe nang malayo at gumastos nang malaki para lamang mabigyan ng kinakailangang serbisyo ang kanilang mga anak.

Ang ganitong mga mungkahi ay nagpapakita na ang usapin ng autism ay hindi lamang tungkol sa ayuda. Ito ay tungkol sa pagkakaroon ng isang komprehensibong sistemang nagbibigay ng pantay na oportunidad sa bawat batang may espesyal na pangangailangan.

Sa pagpapatuloy ng "Akay ni Gob sa May Autism," nabibigyan ng pag-asa ang maraming pamilyang matagal nang naghahangad na mapansin ang kanilang kalagayan. Ang tunay na tagumpay ng programa ay hindi lamang masusukat sa dami ng mga nairehistro, kundi sa lawak ng serbisyong maihahatid at sa kalidad ng buhay na maibibigay sa mga batang may autism.

Sa huli, ang isang lipunang may malasakit ay nasusukat sa paraan ng pag-aaruga nito sa mga pinakamahirang sektor. At kung ang bawat batang may autism ay mabibigyan ng sapat na suporta, pagkakataon, at pag-unawa, mas magiging makatarungan at mas makatao ang kinabukasan para sa lahat.

"Kapag hindi sapat ang kinakain ng isang tao o ng isang pamilya sa loob ng maraming araw, maaari silang maging malnourished. Kaya kailangan nating maibsan ang kagutuman upang mabawasan din ang malnutrisyon sa ating bansa. Malaking tulong po itong BBM rice program," dagdag niya.

Bukod sa pamamahagi ng pagkain, binigyang-diin din ng NNC ang kahalagahan ng mga programang pangnutrisyon sa mga paaralan, kabilang ang Gulayan sa Paaralan Program ng Department of Education, na nagtataguyod ng pagtatanim ng gulay, wastong nutrisyon, at pagpapalakas ng seguridad sa pagkain sa antas ng paaralan at tahanan.

Ayon sa konseho, ang mga programang ito ay kaakibat ng layunin ng Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition na mabawasan ang lahat ng uri ng malnutrisyon at mapabuti ang kalagayang pangkalusugan ng mga Pilipino sa pamamagitan ng magkakaugnay na mga programang pangnutrisyon at pangkabuhayan.

Ginagabayan ng internasyonal na batas, nananatiling nakatuon ang pamahalaan sa pagprotekta sa soberanya ng bansa, mga karapatan sa soberanya, at hurisdiksiyon sa dagat habang isinusulong ang kapayapaan at katatagan ng rehiyon.

Ang mga diplomatikong pakikipag-ugnayan, bilateral at multilateral na kooperasyon, at pagsunod sa mga itinatag na internasyunal na legal na mekanismo ay nananatiling sentro ng patakaran ng bansa sa pagresolba sa mga alitan sa dagat.

Ang West Philippine Sea ay binibigyang-diin din ang kahalagahan ng isang wholeofnaton approach sa pangangalaga ng mga maritime na interes ng bansa.

Ang mga ahensya ng gobyerno, mga yunit ng lokal na pamahalaan, ang komunidad ng akademya, mga organisasyon ng lipunang sibil, at ang pribadong sektor ay lahat ay may mahalagang papel sa pagtataguyod ng kamalayan ng publiko, pagsuporta sa konserbasyon sa

dagat, pagpapalakas ng mga komunidad sa baybayin, at paghikayat sa responsableng pagkamamayan. Ang mga kampanya sa pampublikong edukasyon ay patuloy na binibigyang-diin ang kahalagahan ng pag-unawa sa mga karapatang pandagat ng bansa, pangangalaga sa mga marine ecosystem, at pagsuporta sa mga matuwid at mapayapang hakbang sa pagtugon sa mga alalahanin sa dagat.

Para sa proteksyon ng WPS, ang Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), at iba pang kinaaukulan ahensya ng gobyerno ay patuloy na nagsasagawa ng mga legal na maritime patrol, maritime domain awareness operations, humanitarian missions, at support activities para sa mga mangingisdang Pilipino.

Ang mga pagsisikap na ito ay naglalayong tiyakin ang kaligtasan ng mga pamayanang Pilipino sa dagat, protektahan ang yamang dagat, itaguyod ang kalayaan sa paglalayag, at palakasin ang postura ng seguridad sa dagat ng bansa alinsunod sa mga batas ng Pilipinas at internasyonal na batas.

Ang pangangalaga sa West Philippine Sea ay hindi lamang isang usapin ng interes sa teritoryo kundi isa rin sa pambansang kaunlaran at kapakanan ng mga susunod na henerasyon.

Sa pamamagitan ng pagtataguyod ng internasyonal na batas, pagpapalakas ng pambansang katatagan, pagtataguyod ng responsableng pangangasiwa ng yamang dagat, at pagpapaunlad ng pagkakaisa ng mga Pilipino, ang Pilipinas ay patuloy na nagsusumikap ng isang mapayapa na may prinsipiyong pamamaraan sa pagprotekta sa mga lehitimong karapatang maritime nito habang nag-aambag sa kapayapaan, seguridad, at katatagan ng rehiyon.

Sa gitna ng mga panawagang pababain ang edad ng criminal liability sa bansa kasunod ng madudugong krimen sa loob ng ilang paaralan, binigyang diin ni Senate Minority Leader Alan Peter Cayetano ang kahalagahan ng maayos na “total environment” bilang epektibong paraan para mailayo

ang kabataang Pilipino mula sa krimen. Sa isang Facebook livestream nitong June 24, 2026, sinabi ni Cayetano na nauunawaan niya ang panawagan ng publiko para sa hustisya, lalo na ng mga pamilya ng mga biktima. Pero giit niya, hindi kailangang ituring na

“hardened criminals” ang kabataan para mapigilan silang gumawa ng krimen. “I just want to really pray for the parents, for the loved ones ng mga nasawi. And of course, ask people to be sensitive, to pray for them... We understand their cry for justice,” aniya.

Ikinagulat ng

publiko ngayong buwan ang pamamaril ng dalawang estudyanteng menor de edad sa loob ng San Jose National High School sa Tacloban City, kung saan tatlong estudyante ang nasawi at ilan pa ang nasugatan. Bago ito, dalawang magkahiwalay na insidente naman ng panaksak ang kinasang-

kutan ng ilang estudyante sa loob ng kanilang paaralan sa Cavite. “Hindi tayo pwedeng ma-desensitize d’yan (school violence). Hindi pwedeng maging normal iyan,” giit ni Cayetano.

Sa gitna ng panibagong panawagan na amyendahan ang Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act, hinimok ng senador ang mga kapwa mambabatas na maging maingat sa pagbuo ng reporma dahil baka lalo pang mapalapit ang kabataan sa krimen imbes na mailayo sila mula rito.

“It’s really getting to a consensus of what law will be most proactive and relevant to us where we can protect our young people, not expose them to criminality; not treat them as hardened criminals, but also deter them and their parents from going into violence and violent crimes,” aniya.

Sa ilalim ng batas, ang mga batang edad 15 pababa ay hindi maaaring panagutin sa krimen, ngunit isinasailalim sila sa intervention programs sa halip na ilagay sa ordinaryong kulungan. Ang mga batang higit 15 ngunit wala pang 18 taong gulang naman ay maaaring panagutin kung mapatutunayang ginawa nila ang krimen kahit alam na nilang mali; kung hindi ay isasailalim din sila sa intervention.

Giit ni Cayetano, hindi sapat na sagot ang pababain ang edad ng criminal liability sa bansa. Sa halip ay siguraduhin aniya na maayos ang “total environment” ng kabataang Pilipino, kabilang

ang mga napapanood nila online, at ang mga natutunan at nararanasan nila sa paaralan, sa tahanan, at sa kanilang komunidad. “Everything is just a shock to us. So, we have to reflect kung anong tinatanim natin sa isip ng mga bata,” aniya.

Diin niya, dapat manatiling “safest place” para sa kabataan ang kanilang paaralan, tahanan, at ang simbahan.

“The reason po that we’re more sensitive when it is schools, churches, or home is because this is the place where children should be safe,” aniya.

Isa sa mga unang mahahalagang hakbang, ayon kay Cayetano, ay ang solusyunan ang pag-ikli ng school hours dahil sa kakulangan ng silid-aralan.

“Ano naman kinalaman ng K to 12 sa nangyari? Eh guys, half day na lang po most of our schools. I don’t know exactly sa Leyte, but most of our schools sa highly urbanized places are half day. So mas madami pang oras ang bata sa lansangan at saka sa social media,” paliwanag niya.

Binigyang-diin ng senador na dapat kumilos ang bansa kaugnay nito nang may karunungan dahil ang kabataan aniya ang pinakamahalagang yaman ng Pilipinas.

“Ang number one resource natin is not oil or gas or gold or livestock. It’s our children,” aniya.

“We have to have very, very deep thought into this problem because existential ‘to sa pamilya ng bawat Pilipino,” dagdag niya. PR

Palace Denies Extension for PRO CALABARZON Chief Hansel Marantan, Set to Retire on July 10



The Malacañang Palace has confirmed that the requested one-year extension of service for PBGEN Hansel Marantan will not be granted, paving the way for his mandatory retirement on July 10, 2026.

During a press briefing on Thursday, Claire Castro announced that the request for Marantan’s extension had not been approved despite an appeal from Jonvic Remulla to the National Police Commission.

“Wala pong extension para po kay General Marantan. Maaari po siyang makatulong sa ibang pamamaraan,” Castro said, emphasizing that while his tenure as regional director will end, the government believes he can continue contributing through other capacities. Marantan, who

currently heads the Police Regional Office 4A, has been widely recognized for his leadership and law enforcement initiatives throughout the CALABARZON region. His career has also been marked by controversies and challenges, but many supporters regard his journey as one of resilience, redemption, and dedicated public service.

The request for a one-year extension was earlier endorsed by Remulla in recognition of Marantan’s performance and leadership.

However, with the Palace’s confirmation, the police general will retire upon reaching the mandatory retirement age of 56 on July 10, officially concluding his decades-long career in the Philippine National Police.

Cavite ramps...

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) – To better serve its population of over 4.3 million, the Provincial Government of Cavite is further strengthening its public health services through modernized healthcare facilities and enhanced support for healthcare workers.

Following his inspection of local health facilities last May, Governor Francisco Gabriel Remulla announced that the Provincial Government has allotted a total of Php 500 million to upgrade the General Emilio Aguinaldo Hospital (GEAMH) and the Cavite Center for Mental Health.

In a statement, Remulla said the provincial government will allot Php 300 million to GEAMH and the remaining Php 200 million to the Cavite Center for Mental Health. The funds will cover the rehabilitation and improvement of hospital infrastructure as well as the procurement of modern medical equipment.

“Naglaan ang pamahalaang panlalawigan ng Cavite ng Php 300 milyon para sa pagpapa-gawa ng mga ospital, at masuportahan ang ating healthcare workers upang mas maayos at mas mabilis ang serbispong natatanggap ng bawat Caviteño.”

The local chief executive added that the province will continue to modernize local hospitals and provide support to medical frontliners as part of its continuous bid to improve the local healthcare system.
